In the sequence, Xavier et al. (2018), the article "Is psychic distance still relevant for internationalization decisions?" aimed to identify the determinants of psychic distance and the strength of their influence in decisionmaking during the internationalization process of firms. Finally, Pastana et al. (2018) present their article entitled "Innovative strategies in the planning of sustainable urban mobility" that aims to identify in the scientific literature works related to innovative strategies in the planning of sustainable urban mobility. We would like to congratulate the authors and hope that readers enjoy the scientific content of this edition.
